Date	Session Number	Session Title	Description
June 1-5, 2020	Session 1A	The Cooking Atelier – Part 1	Children will begin the Cooking Atelier with an exploration of gardening, harvesting and shopping for excellent ingredients to build their favorite summer recipes. Budding Chefs will learn to use kitchen tools safely, develop recipes and learn the basics of seasonal cooking.
	Session 1B	Recycled!	Thinking beyond the cardboard challenge, children will develop and invent ways to reuse recyclable materials. This camp will also delve into the concepts of environmental awareness, sustainability, conservation and explore ways that we can all become environmentally responsible citizens.
June 8-12, 2020	Session 2A	The Cooking Atelier – Part 2	During Part 2 of the Cooking Atelier children will continue their exploration of local gardens and farms, and dive deeper into recipe development and cooking. The week will culminate in a feast for parents and special guests, prepared entirely by the children.
	Session 2B	Spanish	In a Spanish immersion environment, children will explore Spanish language, food, music and culture.
June 15-20-2020	Session 3A	Lego Challenge (4 & 5-year-olds)	Children will be challenged to use their imaginations to create fantastic structures through use of open-ended brick building. An introduction to robotics will be provided by Bricks for Kids.
	Session 3B	Lego Challenge (6 thru 8-year-olds)	
June 22-26, 2020	Session 4A	Music & Sound (4 & 5-year-olds)	In this camp, the children will discover the inner secrets of sound and music. We will explore timbre, texture and the properties of musical instruments from drums to flutes. We will also play music together and learn how musicians work with one another to create beautiful tapestries of sound.
	Session 4B	Music & Sound (6 thru 8-year-olds)	
June 29 – July 3, 2020	Session 5A	Sports & Games	Children will explore basic concepts of popular sports and games. During this camp children will visit parks and fields to practice skills, drills and good sportsmanship.
	Session 5B	Mad Scientists	Children will embark on a scientific research journey through experiments and exploration of scientific concepts. Daily experiments will engage the mind and body as children test their hypotheses and fulfill their curiosity.
July 6-10, 2020	Session 6A	The Amazing Atelier (4 & 5-year-olds)	Art is Life! This session will seek to embrace art as an experience of expression that engages the senses and the creative young mind. Art will come to life each day as we explore paint, clay, paper mâché, wire, wood working and more.
	Session 6B	The Amazing Atelier (6 thru 8-year-olds)	
July 13-17, 2020	Session 7A	Imagination Station – Part 1	Children will explore the art of oral storytelling, story and character development, book-making and performance. Individual and group stories will be developed and recorded. The week will culminate in a final original script and beginning performance.
	Session 7B	Outdoor Adventures	Students will take daily trips to natural, outdoor locations and participate in nature hunts, hiking water play, outdoor games and animal and insect investigations.
July 20-24, 2020	Session 8A	Imagination Station – Part 2	During Part 2 of Imagination Station, children will refine their final script, development stage sets and costumes and practice performing their story. The week will culminate with a performance for parents and special guests.
	Session 8B	Superhero Challenge	Children will embrace all of the things we love about superheroes and explore the many ways that all of us exhibit “super” qualities. Children will create their own super identity through costume making, storytelling and heroic deeds.
