Information About Sessions

Music, Drama & Performance – This session will focus on the interconnection between art, storytelling, and performance. The week will start with a child-led vote to see which well known children's tale the group would like to explore, then delve into the process of bringing that story to life. The group will explore art through set and costume design, experience story telling through book-making and the oral story tradition, and experience performance through a multi-classroom performance at the culmination of the session. In addition, daily dance parties will be inspired by cultural music from across the world.

Art as Experience – In our Reggio-inspired setting, we believe that art is life! This session will seek to embrace art as an experience of expression that engages the senses and the creative young mind. Each day will be a journey into the properties and possibilities of a specific material or art making process. Individual and collaborative projects will center on work with clay, paint, paper mache, and recycled materials collage.

Crazy about Cooking and Science – From making bread to launching rockets, this session will focus on the excitement of science and transformation. Each day will be based around two projects: one cooking project and one science experiment. Through hands on experience with interesting foods and participation in wonder provoking science experiments, the group will examine the world around them.

Outdoor Excursions – Students will take a daily field trip to a natural, outdoor location and participate in nature hunts, hiking, outdoor games, animal and insect investigations, etc. Students will be away from school for a significant portion of the day and will need to bring a sack lunch each day.
