Information About Sessions

Color & Line Art Experiences – In our Reggio-inspired setting, we believe that art is life! This session will seek to embrace art as an experience of expression that engages the senses and the creative young mind. Each day will be a journey into the properties and possibilities of color mixing and line design. Individual and collaborative projects will center on work with watercolors, tempura paints, various drawing techniques, and collage.

Storytelling & Book Making – This session will focus on the interconnection between art and storytelling. The first week will focus on exploring a well-known folktale through various adaptations such as books, film, oral storytelling, light and shadow play, and acting. The group will explore these different styles of storytelling and immerse themselves in the story. The second week will focus on the children sharing their stories through the step by step process of book making.

3-Dimensional Art Experiences – This session will seek to bring art alive by seeing it in another dimension. Our visual interpretations will leave the paper and we will explore new materials. Each day will be a journey into the properties and possibilities of clay, paper mache, wire, and wood working.

Outdoor Adventures – Students will take a daily field trip to a natural, outdoor location and participate in nature hunts, hiking, outdoor games, animal and insect investigations, etc. Students will be away from school for a significant portion of the day and will need to bring a sack lunch each day.
