Information About Sessions

Session 1, The Many Worlds of Music – Music influences every aspect of our life. This camp will be infused with music from around the world. Children will explore art, science, culture and movement through a multitude of musical genre and examine the many ways that music affects the human spirit. Hands on music and instrument making will accompany our explorations.

Session 2, Legos: Exploring Building and Architecture – Legos offer a world of open-ended possibilities. In this camp children will be challenged to create interesting and complicated structures and figures and will explore properties of building and architecture.

Session 3, The Cooking Atelier – More than just “cooking with children”, the cooking atelier will encourage imagination and creativity as children explore the bounty and variety of seasonal summer recipes. Budding Chefs will learn to use kitchen tools safely, shop for ingredients, experiment with tried and true recipes and develop recipes of their own.

Session 4 and 7, Outdoor Adventures – Students will take a daily field trip to a natural, outdoor location and participate in nature hunts, hiking, water play, outdoor games and animal and insect investigations. Students will be away from school for a significant portion of the day and will need to bring a sack lunch each day. Adventure sites will be determined and sent to camp participants before the beginning of camp.

Session 5, Everyone is a Scientist – Children are naturally curious and explorative. This camp will tap into this inquisitive nature as we embark on a scientific research journey. Daily experiments and the answers to “Why?” will make this camp exciting and engaging for budding scientists and explorers.

Session 6, The Amazing Atelier – In our Reggio-inspired setting, we believe that art is life! This session will seek to embrace art as an experience of expression that engages the senses and the creative young mind. We will seek to bring art alive by seeing it in multiple dimensions. Each day will be a journey into the properties and possibilities of paint, clay, paper mache, wire, and wood working.

Session 8, Superhero Challenge – Everyone loves a superhero! This camp will embrace all of the things we love about superheroes and bring out the many ways that all of us exhibit “super” qualities. Children will explore their favorite superheroes and create their own super identity through costume making, storytelling and a hero’s performance.
