



Summer Camp Descriptions 2026

Session 1 - May 27-291, 2026

Spring Into Summer: Welcome to Summer! For this three-day session, campers will be engaged in a variety of creative activities, water play, outdoor play and fun with friends.

Session 2A - June 1-5, 2026

The Atelier - Process Art: Perfect for our sensory seekers, this camp will involve paint, clay, glue, slime, light, water and more. As the title suggests, we will be focused on enjoying the process of art with a variety of materials, whether it be delicate drizzling of glue lace or a whole body paint experience! Sometimes our processes lead to a beautiful end result and other times the beauty lies in the joy of the process itself. (This camp is limited to 12 children.)

Session 2B - June 1-5, 2026

Superhero Universe: In this Super Session campers will embrace the magic and excitement of Superheroes. Our Superhero Universe will include exploring characteristics of superheroes that we all know and love and the creation of new superheroes. We will combine the ideas of justice, courage and extraordinary ability with our imaginations to create super stories and, perhaps, our own graphic novel.

Session 3A - June 8-12, 2026

The Atelier of Taste: For adventurous young foodies, this camp will take our taste buds around the world! We will explore different and new flavors and scents and follow recipes from countries around the world. A little closer to home, we will explore how food can build community and responsibility. We will also delve into scientific reactions of ingredients through conducting experiments to answer questions and make new discoveries. (This camp is limited to 12 children.)

Session 3B - June 8-12, 2026

Legos & Robotics: Legos combine imagination and creativity with engineering, technology and math concepts. In this session, campers will build, create, problem solve and investigate to bring new life, energy and movement to the playful imagination inherent in children's Lego creations.

Session 4A - June 15-19, 2026 (closed June 19th)

Forest Adventures: Forest Adventures campers will be outdoors most of the day. Each day will include a field trip to a natural, outdoor location and include hiking, climbing, active play, picnicking. **Campers will bring their own lunch each day.** (This camp is limited to 12 children.)



Session 4B - June 15-19, 2026 (closed June 19th)

Wild Kingdom: In this session, campers will explore all of the wild things! From jungle and forest animals, animals from the land, water and sky, creepy crawlly creatures, and our favorite pet companions - we will explore them all! This camp features investigation, animal encounters and opportunities to learn more about inhabitants of the natural world. Campers will also explore concepts of extinction, preservation and care for animals.

Session 5A - June 22-26, 2026

The Atelier - Natural Art: There is so much art in nature that we are often too busy to appreciate. This week we plan to slow down and notice the beautiful colors in nature and all the rich, natural materials we can gather and use to make art. Print-making, natural dyes, flower dehydrating, clay, drawing and foraging are just some of the offerings for this fun-filled week of nature art. (This camp is limited to 12 children.)

Session 5B - June 22-26, 2026

Music Camp with Ms. Sara: In this session, campers will explore rhythms, music and sounds across many genres of music. We will bring out our favorites and venture into sounds and songs unknown to broaden our knowledge and appreciation of music and musical concepts. These interactive experiences will take children's understanding to a new level and send them home singing!

Session 6A - June 29-July 3, 2026 (closed July 3rd)

Forest Adventures: Forest Adventures campers will be outdoors most of the day. Each day will include a field trip to a natural, outdoor location and include hiking, climbing, active play, picnicking. **Campers will bring their own lunch each day.** (This camp is limited to 12 children.)

Session 6B - June 29-July 3, 2026 (closed July 3rd)

Space Explorers: To infinity and beyond! This session will take campers as far out as their ideas and imagination can take them. From scientific and factual to the affinity for the great unknown, we will explore every aspect of space and space travel and, perhaps, UFOs and elusive visitors from afar.

Session 7A - July 6-10, 2026

The Atelier - Textiles and Jewelry: Fibers, threading, dyes, and beads, in an array of textures, colors, and styles for young designers to incorporate in their work. We will look at wearable art, textiles in art, and be inspired by cultures from around the world. **This camp is for children ages 6-10.** (This camp is limited to 12 children.)



Session 7B - July 6-10, 2026

Ultimate Fort Building: Using children's natural tendency to create their own cozy, comfy and exclusive spaces, campers will use a multitude of materials to build and create forts big and small. Their imagination is the only limit as children use all sorts of adornments to create their own unique space. From the ultimate hiding spot to the ultimate friends fort, this is the ultimate fort building experience!

Session 8A - July 13-17, 2026

The Atelier - Mark Making and Drawing: Children will be offered a wide range of mark making tools from charcoals to watercolor pens, and even glitter markers! We will look into the free process of mark making, noticing different styles such as abstract art and purposeful line drawings letting the work of famous artists inspire our work as we learn together. (This camp is limited to 12 children.)

Session 8B - July 13-17, 2026

Full STEAM Ahead: Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics. STEAM camp at the Willow School explores the necessary integration of imaginative, academic and technical aspects of critical thinking. We will dive into science projects, creative processes, hypothesising and problem solving that combine play, learning and the construction of knowledge.

Session 9 - July 20-24, 2026

Board Game Bonanza: For the last session of the summer, campers will play all of their favorite games, discover new games and create their own games. We will have table board games, outdoor games, as well as life size action versions of popular favorites.
